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Steps to follow:

Select whether NRC(A) or CHEDS paperwork will be used. Your state Breed Recorder will issue the appropriate paperwork. For an overview of the CHEDS scheme see [Canine Health Database \(ankc.org.au\)](http://Canine Health Database (ankc.org.au)).

1. Post completed Application to the Breed Recorder in your State/Territory with a copy of the Registered Pedigree and an A4 stamped self-addressed envelope for return of documents. The State Breed Recorder will advise if a cost will be incurred for paperwork (Direct Deposit is preferred) or cheque, no cash please. Please use your name as the Reference. Bank details BSB Account number
2. **NRC(A) ID Number is required on CHEDS Paperwork.** This will be typed on the form and will be the same number that is on the Eye/Mouth Certificates. **The email address of the NRC(A) Breed Recorder will be also be included on the form for return of results.**
3. Arrange an appointment to have your dog x-rayed. Take along the paperwork. A copy of the Pedigree is required at the Vets to confirm ID/Microchip Number. It is the Owners responsibility to ensure all details are entered and correct prior to the dog/bitch being x-rayed and to advise their Vet of the ID requirements on X-Rays.
4. **The Vet must assess the bite while the dog is awake.** Counting teeth is best done while the dog is under anaesthetic. The Hip & Elbow X-ray must be taken under General Anaesthetic.
5. A buccal swab or blood should also be collected for testing for **Juvenile Laryngeal Paralysis Polyneuropathy (JLPP)** and sent to the Laboratory e.g., Laboklin, OFA, or Orivet. When the result and certificate is received it should be forwarded to the NRC(A) Breed Recorder and your State Breed Recorder.
6. The x-ray plates must be identified with the dog's registered name, microchip number, ANKC Registration Number, the individual NRC(A) Identification number, date the x-ray is taken, sex and R and L markers. Make certain that the Vet has completed all parts of the forms he/she is required to.
7. Send X-ray and completed NRC(A) or CHEDS HD/ED paperwork to the reader of your choice from the [NRC\(A\) List of Official Readers](#) together with payment of fees. **Do not send the Eye and Dental Certificate to the Reader.**
8. **Keep the white copy of the completed Dental and Eye Certificate and forward the yellow copy to your State Breed Recorder and the blue copy to the National Breed Recorder.**
9. Results from the Reader should be sent to you, your Vet and the National Breed Recorder whether NRC(A) or CHEDS paperwork is used. The State Breed Recorder will be forwarded a copy from the NRC(A) Breed Recorder. When you receive your result via email from the Reader you may forward these to your State Breed Recorder and the NRC(A) Breed Recorder if you wish. The result will be listed in the National Hip Dysplasia Register once received by the NRC(A) Breed Recorder.

**NOTE: The Hip x-ray and Dental and Eye examination can be done by any Veterinarian.
It is possible to get a Specialist Eye Examination, although not compulsory.**
